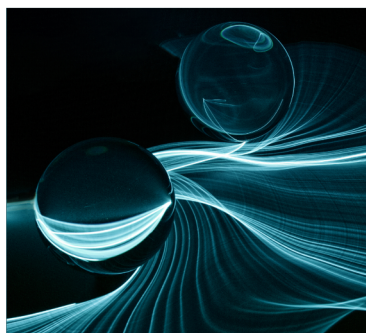


Macro (a closer look at the past week)

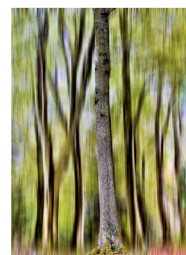
On Wednesday Mike Warren judged the DPI ("Don't Print It") digital version of our Club Print Competition via Zoom.

HUT MEETINGS - Mike (Programme Sec) is arranging 3-4 practical sessions at the Hut during April-June (in parallel to the Zoom programme). The first one is likely to be Wed 13 April involving portraiture (as a follow-on from the zoom talk on Mon 11 Apr). Watch out for more details.

DARKROOM and STUDIO - these can be booked via Mike Tagg. Please check availability on the facilities calendar on the website then email Mike. You will need to collect a key and return it afterwards (details from Mike when booking). Be aware that during the week we have shared part of the Hut to CrossFit Crawley (area nearest entrance door) and they may be holding classes. You can access the darkroom and studio through their workspace (or via the rear fire door which must be closed afterwards.)

The "pre-AGM" meeting is particularly important this year. We need to agree how to move forward with meetings/zoom etc and we need help on the Committee. The new date is Wed 6 April on Zoom (earlier than late April originally in programme). The "pre-AGM" is the time to pull together new ideas to take the Club forward - and is intended to make the AGM in June as straightforward and short as possible.
