


Macro (a closer look at the past week)

His suggestion is to tape the data to your lens cap for quick reference. PhotoPills.Com provides lots of information on depth of field distances (as well as a smartphone app with the info to hand). The site also has some useful <u>free ebooks</u> on DOF etc.
